Prophetic Declaration for Bermuda

Isaiah 42:12 (KJV)

¹²Let them give glory unto the LORD, and declare His praise in the **islands**.

Revelation 21:1-2, 22-26 (NKJV)

¹ Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. ² Then I, John, saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

²² But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. ²³ The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb *is* its light. ²⁴ And the *nations* of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it. ²⁵ Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there). ²⁶ And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the *nations* into it.

² Open the gates,

That the righteous nation which keeps the truth may enter in.

⁷ The way of the just *is* uprightness; O Most Upright, You weigh the path of the just.

⁸ Yes, in the way of Your judgments, O LORD, we have waited for You; The desire of *our* soul *is* for Your name and for the remembrance of You. ⁹ With my soul I have desired You in the night, Yes, by my spirit within me I will seek You early; For when Your judgments *are* in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.

DECLARATION

I/We declare that the God who created the heavens and the earth and everything that is in the earth; who revealed himself through His eternal Son, Jesus the Christ, is exalted in Bermuda and is supreme over all.

I/We declare that we are a people who give glory to God and declare His praise in the islands.

I/We declare that God finds the righteousness of Christ in the people of our island and we will not be overrun by spiritual darkness and depravity.

I/we declare that because God is exalted supreme in our land, the spirit of oppression that reveals itself in pride, greed, covetousness and pretense will be dethroned and the Spirit of God will replace in us true humility, compassion, and generosity. The sense of purposelessness and hopelessness that exists across the generational divide will be replaced with a vision of opportunity and a sense of destiny.

I/we declare that wisdom, justice, judgment and equity will enter and increase in our leaders and throughout our land.

I/we declare that because righteousness exalts a nation, and when it goes well with the righteous the city rejoices; we as a people determine to live in the righteousness of God and see righteous transformation in our families, the church, education system, government, political system, justice system, economics, business, media and all forms of entertainment.

I/we declare the spirit of murder be rooted out and the unsolved murders be resolved; that violence, bitterness, immorality, perversion, division, idolatry and selfishness will give way to an abundance of love, peace, joy, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

I/we declare that this island will fulfill its redemption purpose as a resource nation; that just as in 1610 when the ships Patience and Deliverance left these shores and took relief to the early settlers of the Americas, allowing them to be refreshed, healed and restored; that from this land will go forth skills, knowledge and expertise that will bring relief and resources to other nations. Like Joseph in Egypt, after we have endured some trials and testing, we will be a people who are able to; Interpret the times; Conceive a plan and Initiate an action that not just benefits us, but also nations around us.

I/we declare that the selfishness that has blinded us from our true divine potential and purpose will be replaced with a selfless heart and release us into our preferred destiny.

I/we declare that a generation will rise to truly break the deception and divisiveness of racism in our land and that we will experience a new spirit of community and corporation.

I/we declare that we will be a nation known for balancing wealth and benevolence; we will not abort our assignment by attempting to be like other nations to attract wealth, but we will confidently be who God has called us to be; a distribution center; a sending nation; and God will make all grace abound to us and give us an abundant supply for every good work. Our godly humility will be our strength.

I/we declare that visitors will not just come for surf, sun and sand but for revival, restoration and refreshing. People who come to our shores will declare that the glory of God is in this place. They will not just come for work opportunities but for solutions to challenges in their own lands.

I/we declare that God will raise up leaders across this land with vision beyond personal gratification at public expense, but will see the people as the Island's natural resource and will embark on a resource development strategy that will prepare us to fulfill our redemptive purpose. We will then develop an education system with a purpose.

I/we declare that from this little island will go forth an immense light as an example to the nations. This will not make us arrogant, but thankful to God and perpetuate His blessings for generations to come.
